TWO RUSSIAN PLANS FOR RÂMNICU SĂRAT – OF THE TOWN AND
OF THE BRÂNCOVEANU’S FONDATION COMPLEX
(Summary)

Keywords: Russian plans, topography, Râmnicu Sărat, city plan, Brâncoveanu.

In this study the author presents two Russian plans. The first, of the city, is from 1807, and the second, of the *Monastery of the Dormition of the Theotokos*, from 1770. The two plans bring new information about the history and urban development of Râmnicu Sarat. Several places of worship were noted in the legend of the city plan, some of which no longer exist today. The walls of the enclosure and the annexes of the monastic complex were accurately drawn on the plan of the monastery.
